Policy Commitments

- Promoting a positive safety and well-being culture by fostering strong safety leadership, providing ongoing training and development, resources, and support to equip employees and contractors to work safely and responsibly
- Striving for zero harm by embedding preventative measures and promptly investigating incidents to address root causes and implement corrective actions to prevent recurrence
- Establishing clear health and safety targets, communicating them effectively, and measuring progress through regularly reviewing our safety performance
- Encouraging the mental and physical well-being of our workforce through supportive programs and resources
- Building a workplace culture where employees and contractors understand their role in ensuring their own safety and that of others, while feeling empowered to raise concerns and contribute to a safer work environment
- Protecting sensitive information and mitigate security risks through rigorous protocols to ensure the resilience and integrity of operations
- Sourcing responsibly by prioritising suppliers and service providers who uphold high health and safety standards across our supply chain
- Ensuring emergency preparedness by maintaining and improving effective response plans and resources.
